



Electrical Technician

The incumbent of the position reports to the Director of Engineering and Technical Services and is in charge of the maintenance and service requests for the charging infrastructure.

The mandate:

- Perform repairs on customer charging stations;
- Maintain relationships with other departments, internal and external clients;
- Respond to various service calls;
- Contribute to the modification, enhancement, and implementation of charging infrastructure;
- Assemble charging stations and pedestals;
- Provide support to the technical service team;
- Conduct visits to customers to gather information about electrical infrastructure;
- Generate required documentation, create electrical sketches using software;
- Perform any other tasks related to the position.

- Holds a DEC in Electrotechnology or a DEP in Electromechanics combined with an AEC in Automation;
- Possesses excellent written French skills;
- Has knowledge in networking (IP addressing), computing, and system configuration (software and firmware updates);
- Is familiar with Quebec's electrical standards;
- Is prepared for travel, capable of conducting electrical installation analyses, calculating electrical input loads;
- Exhibits leadership qualities, resourcefulness, organizational autonomy, and motivation to tackle significant challenges;
- Is proficient in the Microsoft Office suite (Excel, Word, PowerPoint, Visio);
- Is able to speak English
- Has knowledge about Zero Emission Vehicles (ZEVs).
